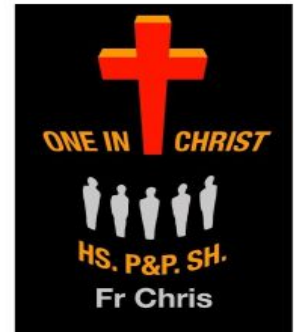

Choir Volunteers:

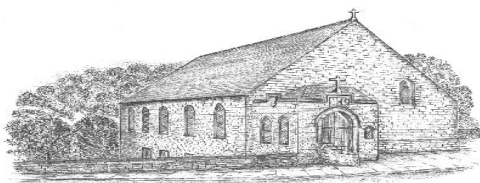

Date for Your Diary:

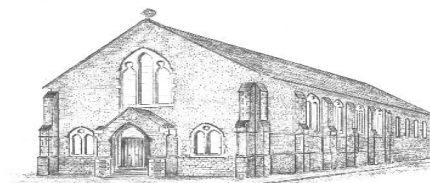

Charity Organizer:

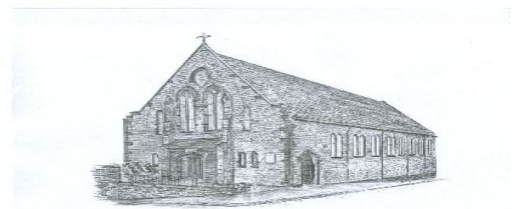
