Parish Africa Project:

This isn't a request for money, just for help to make the money we have all raised have the biggest impact it can! As part of our work with our friends in Kenya at Don Bosco Embu, we have identified a way for the students in Embu to put rubbish to good use in making turbines and other products they can sell to earn money for the schools and college and helping them to deal with the huge problem of discarded plastic bottles as well as developing skills and generating income. We need help from here in Pendle to make some simple machines to send out to Embu so that they can shred the bottles and turn the plastic into new products through melting, extruding and moulding. Designs and drawings are available and we have funds to buy materials and components but we need hands and brains to help procure the parts and assemble the machines. We also need local knowledge of any suppliers who may be able to help with activities such as laser cutting or bending the metal. One fairly key point, we need to make the machines by 20th July so that they can be put into the container with the turbine and equipment we are sending out.

River Power Pod:

Steve Burrows from Cafod has informed us that two of the bikes, donated by members of our parish, will be ridden from Nairobi to Embu over the summer, to support the River Power Pod. The Dawes bike will be ridden by Fr Chris Gorton and Steve will be on the Raleigh. We wish them good luck and a safe journey! Fr Peter.
